Course Information

Extreme Orthopaedics can be defined as extremely intelligent, creative and innovative solutions to the most challenging surgical cases in the Orthopaedic world. This includes oncology, complex revision and trauma cases that require mega-prosthesis as a treatment option.

This course has been developed for Orthopaedic surgeons interested in learning more about the increasing use of Endoprosthetic replacements for complex revisions, trauma and oncology. Participants will be exposed to the surgical treatment and management of complex revisions, trauma and oncology that require Endoprosthetic replacements for severe bone loss. Participants will also learn about soft tissue management associated with this type of surgery.

- Become acclimated to the uses of Mega-prosthesis as a treatment option.
- Understand the functions of and relationships among implant types and the specific instrumentation required to prepare the bone.
- Gain confidence in Extreme Orthopaedic surgeries
